This role involves developing and executing test plans, identifying defects, and working with development teams to resolve issues. The analyst will also be responsible for implementing and maintaining quality assurance standards and processes to enhance the overall efficiency and effectiveness of IT services.

- Assist with testing of periodic (monthly) maintenance activities.
- Perform Quality Assurance (QA) functions for/in using .NET, SQL, HTML, XML, SOAP, Java Script and AJAX programming environments.
- Install and integrate new QA software programs into existing environments.
- Collaborate with business stakeholders to coordinate or facilitate User Acceptance Testing.
- Perform and recommend security audits/enhancements on assigned systems



- Program analysis and support analyzes documentation and technical specifications of any new application under deployment or consideration to determine its intended functionality.
- Review documentation to ensure that requirements stated are correct, unambiguous and verifiable
- Prepare and deliver reports, recommendations or alternatives that address existing and potential trouble areas in ITS systems and projects across the organization.
- Conduct internal audits to measure and assure adherence to established quality assurance standards for software development, application integration and information system performance and corresponding documentation.
- Make recommendations for improvement of applications to programmers and software developers or engineers.
- Collaborate with Programmer Sr to build automation suites and to execute automated regression suites as needed including running them through Jenkins.
- Identify, document, and track defects and issues, collaborating with development teams to resolve them.
- Perform various types of testing, including functional, regression, integration, and performance testing.
- Ensure adherence to quality assurance standards and best practices.
- Provide detailed reports on testing activities, including test results, defect status, and quality metrics.
- Participate in requirement and design review meetings to provide feedback from a quality assurance perspective.
- Work closely with cross-functional teams to understand project requirements and objectives.
- Continuously evaluate and improve testing processes and tools to enhance efficiency and effectiveness.
- Mentor and guide junior QA analysts as needed.
